^C Rider must have experience in more than 4 rounds in Novice categories or other of 2023 and 2024 for safety reasons and rider must not compete in Pro categories in that year under the same title.

^D For #21, #22 category that has the age regulations, the age calculation will use the starting date of Asian championships which is 5 June 2024. (The rider should be born during 6 Jun 2008 – 5 Jun 2011).

The rider must be certified by 3 Pro or Expert riders and rider's parents. In the case of more than 10 crafts, all riders have to compete in the HEAT&LCQ for qualifying, max. 10 crafts in moto.

^E For #23-#26 category that has the age regulations, the age calculation will use the starting date of the tournament which is 10 December 2024. (The riders should be born during 11 Dec 2011 – 10 Dec 2016)

* For the 25 -26 categories, the "standard" engine modification must comply with the tournament's regulations only which will be officially announced on www.jetski-worldcup.com

** Any class having less than 5 participating boats will be canceled.

** All Thai riders winning cash prize will be deducted 5% tax on their prize money. For the international riders winning the prize money, the cash prize will be deducted following the regulations of the Sports Authority of Thailand and the Progressive Tax Rates of the Revenue Department of Thailand.

** For riders who get the prize money, please cash your cheque within 6 months from the date shown on the cheque. If the cheque expires, the organizer reserves the right to cancel the cheque without reissuing the new one.

** We reserve the right to change information at any time without prior notice.

2. Trophy and Prize Money (Overall)

The total prize money is over 12,513,500 THB.

2.1. WGP#1 WATERJET WORLD CUP

2.1.1. "WGP#1 WATERJET WORLD CUP trophy" will be awarded to the winners of the 6 pro categories: Pro Ski Grand Prix, Pro Sport GP, Pro-Am Runabout 1100 Open, Pro Runabout GP, Pro Freestyle and Pro-Am Endurance Open

2.1.2. For the rest, WGP#1 WATERJET WORLD CUP event trophies will be awarded to the **top 5 winners** in each category.

2.1.3. The medals will be awarded to the **top 10 winners** in each category. The top 5 winners will get the medals at the award ceremony. The 6th until the 10th positions can collect their medals at the Race Center on the 2nd floor of the grandstand within 30 minutes after the award ceremony of each class.

2.1.4. Prize money will be awarded to the top 3 winners in each category.

2.2. WGP#1 WATERJET WORLD SERIES

2.2.1. "WGP#1 WATERJET WORLD SERIES Trophy" will be awarded to the winner of all categories which shown in item 1.

2.2.2. Prize money will be awarded to the top 3 winners of Pro Ski Grand Prix, Pro Sport GP, Pro-Am Runabout 1100 Open, Pro Runabout GP, Pro-Am Endurance Open and Pro-Am Women Ski Modified.

2.2.3. Certificate will be awarded to all riders, and you can download the electronic certificate at www.jetski-worldseries.com since Jan 10, 2025.

2.3. WGP#1 WATERJET ASIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS

2.3.1. "WGP#1 WATERJET ASIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS Trophy" will be awarded to the winner of all categories which shown in item 1.

▶ 3. The rule of participation in the final round, WGP#1 WATERJET WORLD CUP 2024 tournament

3.1. WGP#1 WATERJET WORLD SERIES 2024

3.1.1. For riders who have participated in 2 rounds of WGP#1 Waterjet World Series 2024 and have the scores from 2 rounds", they will get a right to apply to compete in WGP#1 Waterjet World Series 2024 – Final round automatically in that category. (In case the number of riders in each category is higher than specified, all riders have to compete in the HEAT&LCQ for qualifying.)

3.1.2. Top 10 of #1 Pro Ski Grand Prix and #4 Pro Runabout GP, the riders with **top 10 highest accumulated scores** from 2 rounds; Poland and USA of the tournament 2024, will get the rights to participate in "the moto" of the final round, with no need to race in the qualify rounds in case of number of riders is over the tournament limit.

3.1.3. Top 5 of #2 Pro Sport GP and #3 Pro-Am Runabout 1100 Open, the riders with **top 5 highest accumulated scores** from 2 rounds; Poland and USA of the tournament 2024, will get the rights to participate in "the moto" of the final round, with no need to race in the qualify rounds in case of number of riders is over the tournament limit.

3.1.4. Top 5 of another categories, the riders with **top 5 highest accumulated scores** from 2 rounds; Poland and USA of the tournament 2024, will get the rights to participate in "the moto" of the final round, with no need to race in the qualify rounds in case of number of riders is over the tournament limit.

3.2. WGP#1 WATERJET WORLD CUP 2024

- 3.2.1. For the 1st-4th categories and Pro Freestyle, the riders will be certified by IJSBA affiliated associations, or any associations appointed by WGP#1 in the country they represent. Each nation is allowed to send maximum 4 riders/category. (In case the number of riders in each category is higher than specified, all riders have to compete in the HEAT&LCQ for qualifying.)
- 3.2.2. For the other categories of the tournament, the rider can apply directly with the organizer.
- 3.2.3. Riders must have official rider license suitable with the category that you compete in.

3.3. WGP#1 WATERJET ASIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS 2024 (Race Notice of WGP#1 WATERJET ASIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS)

- 3.3.1. For the 1st-4th categories, the riders with top 4 highest scores from Round 1 in Japan will get the right to apply to compete in WGP#1 Waterjet World Cup, Thailand 2024 in that category. (In case the number of riders in each category is higher than specified, all riders have to compete in the HEAT&LCQ for qualifying.)

► 4. Rules

- 4.1. **The rules of IJSBA 2024 will be applied.** <https://ijsba.com/ijsba-competition-rule-book/>
- 4.2. **“Official Rider’s Meeting”** we will have 2 groups of meeting and riders who do not participate will be deducted 15 points from their race scores or may be disqualified. (The riders must register and take a photo before entering the meeting.) Cell phone is not allowed during the meeting. The meeting will be held at D Varee Hotel’s meeting room. You will be notified if there is any change.
- “Categories 6th and 10th - 22nd” scheduled on Tuesday 10 December 2024, 7 PM
 - “Categories 23rd – 26th” scheduled on Wednesday 11 December 2024, 7 PM
 - “Categories 1st- 5th and 7th -9th” scheduled on Thursday 12 December 2024, 7 PM
- 4.3. **Back and leg protection**, for safety, all riders must wear back and leg standard protections during competition (Leg protections have to cover the whole lower legs-not only to cover the front leg) except in the ski classes, it is allowed not to wear leg protection but still have to wear back protection. Any riders who do not follow the rule will be disqualified.
- 4.4. **Fuel**, we allow the use of all brands of commercially available only gasoline such as VP, ETS, PTT or Maxima.
- 4.5. **Race number and background**, if your race numbers and backgrounds are not highly visible and do not conform to the rule book for size, shape and color, we will not be held responsible for any scoring issues due to improper numbers.
- 4.6. **“Riders’ photo”** will be used for identifying riders at the starting gate and for promotional and advertising materials. Please send a photo according to our specifications. If your photo does not meet our specifications, we reserve the right to reject your application.
- 4.7. **For the right to use #1**, We will not allow any rider to use #1 for their craft except those who are the champions of 2023 WGP#1 WATERJET WORLD SERIES. These champions can use #1 for their race boats in the class they are the champion only.
- 4.8. **In the case two riders having the same boat number**, we will give that number to the one who completed the application and payment first (first come, first served). To avoid confusion, we do not allow riders who race in the same category to use the same number even with different letters in front of the number.

- 4.9. The “5 appointed Race Directors”, will have the right to make final decisions of all cases. Voting system will be applied and all participants have to accept that their decisions are final. All riders and participants joining this tournament have already read and accepted this official agreement.
- 4.10. The right to set all the tournament policies and rules belongs to the event organizer upon approval from Jet Ski World Cup Grand Prix Co., Ltd. only. All riders and participants joining this tournament have already read and accepted this official agreement.
- 4.11. Unless there is an **official announcement from WGP#1 regarding other rules.**

► **5. Race system**

- 5.1. The final position will be scored by accumulating from all motos using the **IJSBA official Closed Course Point System.** (Freestyle and Endurance apply their own IJSBA scoring system.)

5.1.1. Points system for closed course is as follows:

The position lower than 20th will get 2 points.

- 5.1.2. In case of 2 riders have equal accumulated points, the rider who has the greater number of the first place will get the higher ranking. If still tied, the rider who has the greater number of the second place will get the higher ranking, and so on.

Example: 3 motos

The Rider A has the greater number of 2nd than Rider B, so Rider A got the higher ranking.

- 5.1.3. If still tied, the rider who has the better place in the last moto, will get the higher ranking.

Example: 4 motos

The Rider B has the better position in the last moto, so Rider B got the higher ranking.

- 5.2. When the number of riders is more than the maximum number of watercrafts that the event organizer allows on starting line, Heat & LCQ systems will be used for safety reason. And those classes will race in only 3 motos. (You will be notified if there is any change.)

6. Registration

6.1. WGP#1 WATERJET WORLD CUP, WGP#1 WATERJET WORLD SERIES and WGP#1 ASIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS 2024 application will use online system via www.jetski-worldcup.com only.

6.2. A complete application must consist of:

6.2.1. The completed entry form

6.2.2. IJSBA Jet Ski rider license

- The organizer may require your rider profile including the official 2023 or 2024 race results that you participated for consideration.

- In case you do not have IJSBA Jet Ski rider license, you can apply for a temporary TJSBA license with us. The application fee is 2,500 THB. (Except for the European riders, you can contact and apply the rider license with Mr. Peter de Smet via info@ijsba.eu)

6.2.3. Photo, the required size of the picture is at least 300 dpi or with high resolution if you take it with your smart phone. Please see the attached photo as an **example**.



6.2.4. Copy of passport

6.2.5. Paid entry fee (We will charge all entry fee in Thai Baht (THB) only)

5.3. Please apply **before November 8, 2024**

5.4. After the deadline (5.3), an extra 3,317 THB will be added to the entry fee per category and no application after November 22, 2024 is accepted.
