As per the resolutions of the Asian Association of Waterjet Federation (AAWJF), conducted in collaboration with and endorsed by the WGP#1, the inaugural meeting took place during the WGP#1 Waterjet World Cup 2023 tournament in Pattaya, Thailand. Subsequently, the second meeting was held at the WGP#1 Waterjet Asia Championships 2024 – Round 1 in Osaka, Japan.

AAWJF wishes to inform the National PWC Associations of Asia that its initiatives have advanced significantly, including the official registration of AAWJF under Thai law and regulation. The AAWJF had already applied the necessary documents to the SEAGF Council. Jet ski Sport had been considered and approved in the Final List of Sports, Disciplines, and Events proposed by NOC Thailand for the 33rd SEA Games Thailand 2025. Consequently, the third meeting will be convened and presided over by Mr. Fully Aswar, President of AAWJF, and Pol. Gen. Dechnarong Sutticharnbancha, Deputy President of AAWJF. The agenda items are as follows:

1. Key principles for participation in the SEA Games 2025, Thailand.
2. The subsequent phase in promoting the Asian Games or advancing other jet ski events in Asia.
